One of Breakthrough's long-time ministries is our food outreach. We've been serving the homeless and the poor in the downtown Wichita area since 1983. When people are hungry, they are ill-equipped to manage their day-to-day responsibilities and/or crises with the tools necessary to be successful.

Today, we invite those in need in our downtown community for a morning meal that nourishes and restores the body. We often provide a hearty start: starches for energy, protein for a sense of satiation, and fresh fruit full of antioxidants. All of this is served with a smile that says, "We're glad you're here today." Within this ministry, the numbers of people in need are going up.
